Features of modern CMS

- Easy, but powerful setup and maintenance
- Easy to post content with Admin Site
- Easily manage images, text, videos, etc.
- Built-in site search
- Easily build web pages
- Web Standards Support
- Support new trends (webfonts, CSS animations, RWD, etc.)
- Blogging (chronological posts with comment features)
- RSS Feeds
- Templates & Themes
- Add-ons for enhanced functionality

Advantages of Wordpress

- Easy to start
- Easy to update
- Free or low-cost to setup and maintain
- Tons of templates/themes
- Tons of plug-ins

Disadvantages of Wordpress

- Can be difficult to customize
- Not ideal for complex websites
- Not ideal for large eCommerce websites
- Security issues
